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REQUIREMENTS

- Age Requirement: Teens (aged 13-19). Younger siblings (aged 10+) may accompany an older sibling, but the older sibling must be present.
- Minimum Number of Required Hours: 30 hours throughout a calendar year. Participants are not limited to 30 hours in a year. He or she may volunteer however much desired. Required hours may be achieved via gardening, office aid, special events, cleaning, leading tours, etc.
- Requirements to be a Tour Guide: Participants must be at least, 16 years old and must prove ability to lead tours.

GOALS

- Participants will learn valuable skills for future endeavors such as public speaking, team building, office work, and time management.
- Participants will be able to interpret at least three exhibits in the garden after twelve months. The exhibits to interpret are his or her choice.
- Build life-long friendship and memories.
- At the end of the participant's high school career, if the participant has achieved over 300 volunteer hours, he or she will receive volunteer chords to wear at graduation.
